R.E.	<p>Easter- The children will look at the Easter Vigil in detail and understand its huge significance in the Liturgical calendar.</p> <p>Pentecost- They will also learn about the coming of the Holy Spirit to the disciples and the effect this had on them.</p>	R.E.	<p>The Work of the Apostles- Pupils will understand the significant role the Apostles played in proclaiming the Good News. They will reflect on the work of the Apostles as building the foundations of the Church which continues to proclaim the Good News of Christ today.</p> <p>All That I Am- Children will learn about the changes that happen to their bodies during puberty. Children will learn about personal hygiene and how changes affect them.</p>
English	<p>Classic Narrative Poetry- Children will engage in active reading and investigation of a narrative poem. Through practical activities and discussion, they will explore how writers use language to create dramatic effects.</p>	English	<p>Persuasive Writing- The children will focus on analysing features of persuasive writing and developing a persuasive style in their own writing. They will create their own persuasive speech and perform this to the class.</p> <p>Recounts- Children will form news teams and research a topic to report. They will produce a plan, carry out interviews, collate and analyse the information they have gathered and then write an article or report.</p>
Maths	<p>Decimals- The children will be adding, taking away, multiplying and dividing decimals. They will also be looking at decimals in sequences.</p> <p>Geometry- The first focus will be looking at angles. We will be drawing angles and measuring them in degrees. Identifying angles at a point and one whole turn.</p>	Maths	<p>Measurement- We will convert between different units of metric measure (for example km and m; g and kg; /and ml) We will also be studying volume and capacity. Next, we will be finding the equivalence between metric units and common imperial units. Finally, we will be looking at converting between units of time.</p> <p>Shape- We will be identifying 3d shapes, including cubes and cuboids, from 2d representations. We will then use the properties of rectangles to deduce related facts and find missing lengths and angles. Finally, this half term, we will identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation. We will use the appropriate language and know that the shape has not changed</p> <p>Perimeter and Area- We will be measuring and calculating the perimeter of composite rectilinear shapes in cm and m. We also will be comparing the area of rectangles and estimating the area of irregular shapes.</p>
Science	<p>Living things- We will be studying the life-cycles of mammals, birds, reptiles, insect and plants. We will be focusing on the similarities and differences between the life-cycles.</p>	Science	<p>Our bodies- Children will look at how their bodies change and develop throughout their lives. This will link to the All That I am scheme of work.</p>
Computing	<p>Art- We will be linking our computing with our Themed Curriculum. Children will be researching impressionist artists and presenting their findings in different ways. They will also be using computer programs to create their own impressionist art.</p>		
P.E.	<p>Striking & Fielding- Children will learn how to play the different roles of bowler, wicket keeper, fielder and batter. They will develop their throwing and catching skills. They will also develop tactical skills, in order to improve their understanding of the game.</p> <p>Swimming- We will be completing several swimming activities and focus on water safety.</p>	P.E.	<p>Athletics-The children will focus on developing technical understanding of athletic activity. They will set their own targets, in order to improve their performance.</p>
Themed Curriculum (History, Geography, Art, D & T and Music)	<p>Art- We will be exploring impressionism. We will be finding out what makes an impressionist painting, as well as, studying art by classic and modern painters. Finally, we will be creating our own piece of art work.</p>
